

QUICK START GUIDE:

UNABLE TO PROVIDE REQUIRED INFORMATION?

If you want to register a DOI, you will be required to supply several pieces of information. If one is unavailable, we recommend using one of the following standard machine-recognizable codes. **Selecting the code from the list below will automatically insert it in the form for you.**

(:unac) temporarily inaccessible

(:unal) unallowed, suppressed intentionally

(:unap) not applicable, makes no sense

(:unas) value unassigned (e.g., Untitled)

(:unav) value unavailable, possibly unknown

(:unkn) known to be unknown (e.g., Anonymous, Inconnue)

(:none) never had a value, never will

(:null) explicitly and meaningfully empty

(:tba) to be assigned or announced later

(:etal) too numerous to list (et alia)

(:at) the real value is at the given URL or identifier

None of the above options will work for the PublicationYear property, which requires a four-digit response. If you do not know the PublicationYear, insert 0000 (four zeros).
